Energy Efficiency and Log Homes

Workshop outline:

The importance of energy efficiency of housing increases among home builders and regulators with the increase of energy prices and the awareness of climate change. Log homes are not immune to these pressures. The new building codes in Canada will require minimum energy efficiency performance. Log construction may have difficulty achieving the new standards without changes and paying a lot more attention to construction details and material selection. This seminar will discuss the new energy requirements in Canada and discuss how the finishing of log shells may contribute to meeting these new regulations.
